Under the general direction of the Cash Operations Manager, the Assistant Lead Cook prepares food for The Habit Burger and provides leadership and supervision in the operation.
ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:	• Daily preparation of food according to the recipes and quality standards set by University Dining Services and Habit Burger; reports to the Cash Operations Manager for the daily work assignment; follows instructions given by the manager • Ensures that safe and sanitary food handling procedures are used in their own work as well as the work of those directing. Provides training and retraining to part-time staff on correct safety measures and procedures • Responds promptly to customer needs; responds to requests for service and assistance; able to deal with frequent changes, delays, or unexpected events • Operates all food service equipment safely; instructs other associates on equipment safety • Maintains knowledge of kitchen requirements and brand standards for the successful daily operation of the Habit Burger kitchen • Ensures all food is prepared on time and to brand standard. Provides training and retraining to part-time staff on food preparation procedures • Assist with the accurate and appropriate ordering of food and supplies from various vendors for Habit Burger, modifying ordering of product at any closure to prevent overstocking • Ensure that orders are accurately checked-in and that quality products are received • Provide an accurate monthly inventory of all products and other inventories as needed • Follows instructions, responds to management direction; maintains a positive attitude and good work habits; including proper attendance established by the Cash Operations Manager. • Follows cleaning schedules as set by management. • Perform other duties as assigned by management.
