
Position Description

The Bulldog Bowl Maintenance Assistant is responsible for ensuring the safe, efficient, and continuous operation of all bowling equipment and related systems within the facility. Under the direct supervision of the Building Maintenance Supervisor, this role focuses heavily on the technical upkeep, preventative maintenance, and mechanical troubleshooting of pinsetters, lane surfaces, ball returns, and scoring systems to guarantee a high-quality experience for students, leagues, and guests.

Responsibilities

- Perform daily pre-opening inspections of lanes, approaches, and pin decks, including cleaning and applying precision oil patterns using the facility lane machine.
- Perform daily and scheduled preventive maintenance on mechanical pinsetters to maximize equipment runtime and minimize downtime.
- Diagnose, repair, and maintain ball returns, automatic scoring systems, and lane monitors, responding rapidly to active lane breakdowns during peak play.
- Inspect, maintain, and replace worn or damaged parts, including belts, bearings, bowling pins, house balls, and billiard equipment.
- Maintain a clean, safe, and organized mechanic workshop area, ensuring it remains stocked with necessary tools and replacement parts.
- Track all repairs and preventative maintenance in the facility log, reporting daily status updates and critical mechanical issues directly to the supervisor.
- Support special events and tournaments by preparing lanes and equipment to meet tournament-ready standards.
- Work collaboratively with bowling counter staff and coworkers by sharing ideas and communicating work progress or equipment issues in a constructive manner.
- Perform other related bowling maintenance duties as assigned.

Qualifications

- Must be an enrolled Fresno State student meeting the following requirements:
 - Undergraduate: 6 or more units (int'l: 12 or more); 2.00 cumulative GPA or above
 - Graduate: 4 or more units (international: 9 or more); 3.00 cumulative GPA or above
- Prior related experience or interest in mechanical trades, electrical systems, or utilizing hand tools preferred.
- Ability to work independently, think critically under pressure, and safely troubleshoot mechanical issues in a fast-paced environment.
- Capable of physically climbing atop pinsetter machines to perform inspections and repairs.
- Ability to stand for extended periods and safely lift and carry heavy equipment items (minimum 30 lbs.).
- Must be dependable, responsible, and work well with a diverse population of campus faculty, staff, students, and community guests.
